No hidden charges.

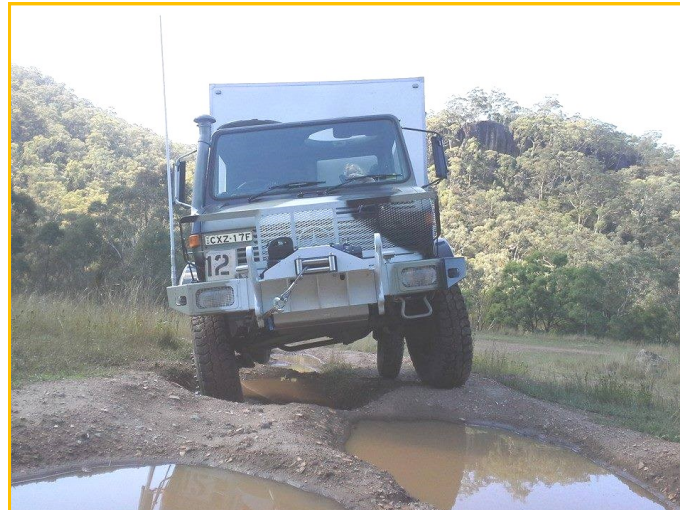
### Where Do I Pay?
